**1. Rules**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING)..
- 1.2. The organizing authority is the Annapolis Yacht Club. The event will be held in the Chesapeake Bay near the Severn River.

**2. Eligibility**

- 2.1. The Regatta is open to all former College Sailors, 50% of the crew shall fall under the following criteria:
  - Women's All American
  - Women's Honorable Mention
  - Co-Ed All American
  - Co-Ed Honorable Mention
  - Crew All American
  - College Sailor of the Year
  - College Sportsman of the Year
- 2.2. All participants will be required to sign and submit a waiver of liability before competing in the regatta.

**3. Registration & Fees**

- 3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form online at <http://www.race.annapolisyc.org> and paying the appropriate, non-refundable entry fee as directed in the online registration instructions.
- 3.2. The entry fee is \$100.00 per person and includes social functions for Skipper and Crew.
- 3.3 Additional Social Tickets are available for purchase, \$40.00 per adult, \$20.00 per child, 12 and under.
