- Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any boat in the following classes:
J/22 Etchells J/24 J/30 Farr 40
Each class must have a minimum entry of 6 boats by Thursday 22 April 2010.
- Rendezvous:** At 1000 in the vicinity of Annapolis Area Mark "X", then proceed to starting area.
- Radio:** Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the race committee.
- Start:** The first warning signal will be at 1045. No race shall be started after 1600.
- Signals:** Five races are scheduled.
- Course:** Special race buoy drop-mark courses as shown in the AYC Event Sailing Instructions.
- Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012* (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the sailing instructions and the notice of race, the sailing instructions shall apply." *Event Sailing Instructions will be available online and at the AYC Clubhouse two weeks prior to the event.*
- Scoring** The Low Point System in RRS Appendix A will apply, except each boat's series score shall be the total of all of her race scores. One completed race shall constitute a series.
- Protests:** For protests involving the rules of RRS Part 2 or RRS 31, an arbitration meeting may be held prior to the protest hearing. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after racing.
- Awards:** 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class. Trophies will be presented at the annual awards party in February 2011.
- Social:** Competitors are invited to gather at the Annapolis Yacht Club after racing. Drink tickets and regatta priced drinks will be available.
